Can I e-mail you my question?

What is "Back and Front?"

Back and front is an open community digital photography competition the culmination of which will be a multi media photo-art installation using two images from each entrant. One back, one front.

Why back and front?

There are two sides to everything and we want you to express this visually, how you see the back and the front. You are free to interpret the brief in any way you wish, as long as you submit two images representing back and front that relate to each other in an opposite sense.

How and what can I take a photo of?

Opposites, polarity, the back and the front of something whatever back in front means to you in every and any sense. This should be limited only by your imagination.

Can I enter this competition?

Yes, you, so can your family, your friends, your group, your school and everybody and anybody else. You MAY NOT submit someone else's work, unless you can supply written permission from them.

Can I view my images.

We will be setting up a digital installation at Open Phoenix Brighton.

When is the deadline?

Saturday 11th October at 5pm.

Why is your competition different?

Because everybody can be involved and everyone's work will be exhibited whether they are winners or not. All you have to do is simply submit two images. And we will do the work we and display each one of your images as two separate projections in the same space, alongside all the other entries.

Why two images?

The idea behind the project is that people get involved in depicting a back and front view of their chosen subject.

What is a subject?

A subject is anything you decide to photograph.

Do I need to use the same subject for back and front? It is not essential, but to enter the competition you must submit two (a pair) photos.

I have two photographs that I have already taken, can I enter these?

Yes as long as they are your own photos.

Can I enter somebody else's photos?

No, unless you have written permission.

What do you mean by displayed digitally?

We will use these images to create a digital installation around the theme of the competition. This will be done by using two projectors within a dark space.

When will these images be displayed?

As part of Brighton Photo Fringe Festival 2008 during Phoenix Brighton Open weekend 11-12th October 2008

Why are you organising back and front?

Back and Front is an exciting creative opportunity for individual involvement and encourages more people to engage in Brighton Photo Fringe Festival in a community group setting.

Who can apply?

The activity is open to everybody of all ages and abilities and will offer an exciting and valuable opportunity for less experienced photographers to get actively involved, learn more and gain confidence around the exhibition / curative process.

TAKING THE BACK AND FRONT PHOTOS

What do I need to do?

You need to use your camera and take a pair of photos, one image depicting the back of a subject and one depicting the back and one the front.

What type of camera can I use?

You can use any digital camera, film camera, a disposable camera, phone camera or even a digital scanner.

If I use the film camera, will you develop the film? No you must develop the film, at the same time you could

get the images transferred onto CD. Send in the CD and file numbers. We will return it if you send in a CD.

Can I send a print? Yes we will copy and return it if you send a SAE

HOW TO ENTER

When is the deadline?

We are taking entries up till 5pm on Saturday 11th October. Although work created that day will not be shown until Sunday 12 October. Prizes will be announced at 5pm on Sunday 5th October. To apply you must pay £5 entry fee.

When do I pay?

The same time that you send your image in.

HOW TO SEND WORK IN

I have a film camera how do I make my image digital? You can get your print scanned on to a CD at any photography shop. For example in Brighton. Boots, Jessops or Kodak.

I have a film camera can I send in prints?

Yes and we will scan it in and return it if you enclose a SAE. Please label the back of your print with your name address and telephone number.

WHAT CAN I SEND IN?

I use a different art form from photography and my work is ideal for this project, can I photo my art from the back and front and enter these two images? Yes as long as the image submitted is a digital photograph.

When you say all images will be displayed will there be any censorship and what images will not be accepted? We reserve the right to refuse entries that could offend people. We will mask images that contain pornography, violence or whatever could offend our viewers.

HOW DO I ENTER THIS COMPETITION?

How Many times can I enter? As many times as you wish, as long as you pay £5 per pair of images submitted.

Where can I get help preparing my images? You can go to a local Photography Shop and ask for assistance.

I have tried to go get help at a local photography shop without any success can you help?

Yes you could come to our drop in workshop on 27th September 10-4pm and we will help you, on a first come first served basis.

I can not make the workshop on 27 September, is there the opportunity to get help?

You could drop in on the day, however it will be on a first come first served basis and your images will not be shown until Sunday 12 October.

I know how to resize, what size would you want these images? 1000 pixels on the longest side at 72dpi

I do not know how to resize, shall I send you the original digital? Yes, preferably on CD

Will you return my CD or print? Only if you include a SAE

What file format should I use? Jpeg

I have a file on my camera phone, how do I get it to you? How do I pay?

If I send a cheque should I send early to give it time to clear?

Yes, cheque entries must be received by Tuesday 7th September. Unless written on the day with a cheque guarantee number.

How much will it cost?

£5 per pair of images.

I am your friend/acquaintance can I get it for free? No, unless you are able to do some in-kind work.

When do I pay?

At the same time as sending in the image.

What is Paypal?

Paypal is a safe way of paying money over the internet. See www.paypal.com

I am sending the image via e-mail, but do not have a Paypal account, can I send in a cheque / postal order separately? Yes please send by post at the same time as e-mailing the image.

I am international and would like to pay. How can I do this?

You can only pay via PayPal. If paying Euro pay 7. If US dollar pay \$10

Do I have to pay £5 per image? No £5 per pair.

What happens if I send only one image in? You still pay £5 and we will reverse the image so two images will be displayed.

WHAT DO I GET IF I WIN?

Firstly this is a competition where it is more that the taking part counts, rather than winning so you are immediately a winner because you have become involved.

When is Brighton Photo Fringe Festival and what is happening during this festival? 3 October - 16 November 2008

The Brighton Photo Fringe Festival occurs during October 2008 once again brings the focus of photography to Brighton. The Brighton Photo Fringe, running parallel to the Brighton Photo Biennial, has grown and multiplied into its third incarnation. This year over 70 exhibitions, including works by hundreds of artists, will proliferate across the city and further into Sussex.

What is Brighton Photo Fringe Festival?
